This event has been specially organised as a relaxing start to the first international Bach Flower Remedies conference.

The *Musical Remedies* concert brings you the chance to unwind in the lovely setting of the historic Felbrigg Hall. The hall is less than 5 miles from Cromer and there is plenty of free parking.

The buffet will feature delicious local food, served in the hall's own prestigious licensed restaurant. The concert will take place in the nearby carriage house & will be presented in two halves with supper in between. The evening will end around 10pm.

The hall, now owned by The National Trust, is mostly Jacobean in style; it was altered in the 1750s and again in about 1840. It is set in extensive gardens, parkland and woods: a guided tour of the grounds is available at 6pm for £1.50 (normal price £3).

The *Musical Remedies* compositions, inspired by each of the flower remedies, are in a contemporary lyrical style. They seek to reflect the inner quality of each remedy in sound.

The concert will be given by Olivia Tebbutt (singer) with the Musical Remedies Quintet led from the piano by the composer, Andrew Morris. You can hear extracts from some of the *Musical Remedies* at www.andrew-morris.com
